SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON GANDHI JAYANTI- On October 1st, Vishwa Bharati Public School, Greater Noida, conducted a special assembly on the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. Dussehra is also known as Vijaya Dashmi. It is a festival observed on the tenth day of Navratri. It is celebrated all over the country and 20 days before Diwali. It is believed that the celebration of Dussehra started in the 17th century when the

king of Mysore ordered the celebration of the day on a grand scale. Indians celebrate this festival with a lot of joy and enthusiasm.
